**Hike to the Drachenfels**

<b>Venue</b>	Auf dem Drachenfels 53639 Königswinter <a href="https://www.der-drachenfels.de">https://www.der-drachenfels.de</a>
<b>Meeting Point</b>	Bonn central station (at Quantiusstrasse in front of the IntercityHotel Bonn) at 13.40 or directly at tram stop Clemens-August-Str. (Königswinter) at 14.19. You can also walk with us from Endenicher Allee 60 to Bonn central station (meeting: in front of the building at 13.30).
<b>Public Transport</b>	From Bonn central station ( <b>Bonn Hbf (U)</b> ), we take line 66 (direction Clemens-August-Str./Bad Honnef) on platform 4a (departure at 13.53) to the tram stop <b>Clemens-August-Str.</b> in Königswinter (arrival at 14.19).
<b>Ticket</b>	CityPlusTicket 2B 5,00 € (one way) <b>Cheaper option:</b> five people can buy a 24h 5 Personen 2B Ticket 23,00 € together
<b>Hike</b>	Starting from tram stop Clemens-August-Str., there are several equally enjoyable hikes to the top of the Drachenfels. We take the route over <b>Nachtigallental</b> which takes about 45-60 minutes. Those who prefer not to walk can alternatively take the Drachenfelsbahn ( <a href="https://www.drachenfelsbahn.de">https://www.drachenfelsbahn.de</a> ) to the top, which operates from 10.00 to 18.00.

The top of the Drachenfels offers a beautiful panoramic view over the Rheintal. On top, one can enjoy the beautiful panorama, view the impressive ruins of Burg Drachenfels (built between 1138 and 1167) or get refreshments. Half way up the Drachensfels is also the Schloß Drachenburg (<https://www.schloss-drachenburg.de>). Its opening hours are 12.00 to 17.00.
